

Recycling Guidelines

All items must be clean, dry & empty.

Items accepted include:

Glass Containers

(Any color food & beverage containers, clear, green, brown)

MUST be clean & dry

Remove all caps and lids, metal and plastic neck rings

Remove plastic wraps

Paper labels are OK

NO tramp glass to include: windows, mirrors, drinking glasses, vases...

NO china or ceramics

Tin Cans

(steel food and beverage cans, aerosol cans, cookie tins, steel screw caps and lids) **WILL STICK TO MAGNET**

MUST be clean & dry NO aluminum cans*

MUST remove one end NO partially filled cans

Non-aerosol cans NO propane cylinders**

Remove any plastic NO scrap metal**

Expel all gas from aerosol cans

Deposit Containers (plastic, aluminum, glass)

MUST be clean & dry

MUST have deposit label intact

Remove caps containers

Place in designated container

Aluminum Foil

(TV dinner trays, pastry trays, and foil items)

MUST be clean & dry NO aluminum cans

Remove any plastic NO "aluminum" bags

NO aluminum coated plastic or paper

Aluminum Cans

(non-deposit food/beverage cans)

WILL NOT STICK TO MAGNET NO aerosol cans

MUST be clean & dry NO Foil Items

Remove any plastic NO lighter refills

Magazines/ Newspaper Inserts

(Catalogs & similar printed materials)

MUST be clean & dry NO tied bundles

Remove any plastic NO bags

Place in designated area NO books*

Plastic Containers

Sort by number on bottom & place in appropriate bin.

1 PET – Clear Only

2 HDPE – Natural (ex: milk jugs)

2 HDPE – Colored

Remove caps, lids & sprayers; remove metal handles & rings.

Rinse&drain detergent bottles; Drain oil containers for 24hrs.

NO plastic bags; NO tied bundles; NO plastic film; NO caps

or lids; NO sprayers or pumps; NO plastic toys or house

wares; NO roofing tar/driveway seal pails. No Styrofoam

Newspaper

Black and white newsprint) **Remove inserts***

MUST be clean & dry & loose. Remove colored comics* &

colored sections* Colored headlines & pictures in the black & white sections are fine.

Office Paper

White Ledger/Computer Print Out/Colored Ledger

Place in designated container NO brown envelopes

Sort by type NO carbon paper

Staples OK NO thermal copy fax

Remove large metal or plastic fasteners

Cardboard

(corrugated boxes, brown paper grocery bags, brown Kraft paper)

Break down flat (open ends) NO boxboard

Remove string from bags NO tied bundles

NO waxed cardboard

NO plastic-coated

Boxboard/Chipboard

(cereal, pasta, detergent, cake, mixes, brown envelopes, etc.)

NO beer and Soda boxes/carriers

Break down flat (open ends)

MUST be clean & dry NO tied bundles

Remove all bag liners NO pizza boxes

Remove cellophane window NO plastic coated/waxed

Remove any metal/plastic parts NO egg cartons

Remove any foil /plastic wrap NO foil coated boxes

Scrap Metal and Appliances

(ex: stove, dishwasher, washer, dryer) are accepted Free of charge. All items must be empty of fluids, food and debris.

Nails/small items need to be in enclosed/covered container.

Appliances containing Freon are charged a \$15 fee.

Electronic Waste

Electronics are not accepted at this location. You may take them to ReSource Barre or Central VT Solid Waste District

Items accepted include plastic 1&2, plastic 3-7, glass, tin, aluminum, newspaper, magazines, cardboard, boxboard **Scrap metal accepted free of charge**. Must be empty of fluids, food & debris



Tires

Under 16" with/without rims	\$2.50 ea.
16.5" - 24" without rims	\$5.50 ea.
16.5"-24" with rims	\$7.50 ea.
Heavy Equipment Tires	\$75.00 ea.

20 tires maximum per day. For large loads, please call ahead!

Construction & Demolition

Grindable Only: \$55.00 per yard

(Small amounts may be accepted by discretion of the Transfer Station Attendant.)

Household Trash

Bagged Household Trash:

\$3.00 per 15 gallon/12.5 lb. bag
\$4.00 per 30 gallon/25 pound bag
\$6.00 per bag over 25 pounds



Carpeting/Padding:

6' x 8' is the Largest accepted *will be charged a \$4.00 per 25 pound bag equivalent

Mattresses/Box Springs:

\$15.00 ea./ Crib Size = \$5.00 ea.

Couches:

Minimum \$20/ \$4/25 pounds (love seat or larger)

Recliners:

Minimum \$15/ \$4 per 25 pounds

Scrap Metals Free
Appliances Free

Refrigerators/Freezers/AC Unit/dehumidifier (requires CFC removal) \$15.00 ea.

Commercial Refrigerators (requires CFC removal) \$75.00 ea.

Helium Tanks (requires valve removal) \$2.00 ea.

Propane Tanks \$10.00 for 20 pound tank

LP gas tanks & cylinders only; 20 pound size limit \$1.00 for smaller tanks
